This year our school theme is *Build each other up* based on 1 Thessalonians 5:11a. We will unpack the theme together over the next ten months!

**Drop off/Pick up:** In the mornings, we ask that you please park and walk your child to the gate on the West side of the school building. Supervision will begin at 8:30 and a Unity staff member will meet you at the gate. We would like to keep our bus loop open for the bus and ask that you please do not park in the loop.

In the afternoon, parents/guardians that are picking up their child (ren), are to park and walk to the gate on the East side of the school building (closest to parking lot) to pick up your child (ren). Please be sure to come to the gate! Students being picked up will be dismissed following the departure of the bus.

We are a **peanut-free facility** which means that lunches and snacks should be packed while carefully checking the labels. Food items may not have peanuts, nuts, any trace of nuts or be made in a facility with nuts. Thanks for your help with this.

In the summer eblast, a **Kindergarten Family Questionnaire** came home. This form helps me to get to know your child a little more as we start this school journey together. Please return that form this week if you have not already done so.

Your child will be coming home with a **Communication Mailbag** on the first day of school. This mailbag (a plastic ziploc bag) is meant to be one means of communication; information from the office and your child's completed work will come home in this bag. Any notes, letters, forms for the office, etc. that you need me to receive should arrive in this mailbag. *Please send the mailbag to school with your child each day.*

**Clothing:** Please remember that your child needs a pair of indoor shoes to be kept at school. And, a full (underwear, shirt, pants, socks) extra set of clothes for your child to be kept at school. A ziplock bag will be coming home in your child's mail bag on Wednesday for you to put the extra clothing in.

**Birthdays** are special and will be celebrated in our class. Each child is encouraged to bring in a favourite book (new or gently used) on or near their birthday. We will read this book together as a class! If you would like the book to remain in the class as an addition to our library, please print the word 'Kindergarten' inside the cover and we will continue to enjoy it at school. Otherwise, the book will be returned to you. Students who have birthdays in the summer will celebrate their birthdays in class near the end of June.

**First Week Chapel** You are invited to join us for our first chapel on Friday morning beginning at 9:15am.

You are also invited to the **CCS Back to School Dessert Social** on Fri., Sept. 9. Classrooms will be open 6:45-7:15 and the dessert social will be 6:30-8pm. We look forward to seeing you then.

**Phew now that's a lot of information! LASTLY, please pray for us; asking God to bless our time together as we get to know one another, adjust to the routines and expectations of Kindergarten.**
